
The Simple Truth about Egg-Shaped Cars



Did William Branham simply describe this picture published in Newsweek Magazine on December 17, 1956?

William Branham said that he wrote the prophecy down in 1933:

I've got that wrote in a book since 1933. August 5, 1960

Before 1958 the prophecy was only about an egg-shaped car:

They'll look like an egg. March 26, 1953

From 1958 onward the prophecy was about remote controlled cars:

It's them cars they're bringing out right now, remote control, for safety. August 5, 1960

He said it was fulfilled in the past:

They got that thing perfected right now.

January 28, 1961

And the company's here that's already ordered them.
August 23, 1964

And the Church Ages book doesn't mention the egg shape:

"...a plastic bubble-topped car that was running down beautiful highways under remote control."
